You will also want to provide them any relevant information that will help them write a letter of recommendation as letters should speak to how you meet the award/scholarship(s) criteria.

** Please note: The Asa B. Johnson Scholarship, Snyder Crumpacker Graduate Fellowship, Dr. R. Stevens Nichols Endowed Scholarship, Brenda Holliday Lloyd Award, and Jessie C. Carpenter Award do not require a recommendation. Please enter your own UVA email in the reference request if you're applying for only one of these scholarships or awards.
