2019 Virginia School Climate Survey

Student Version - Grades 4 & 5

Statewide

This report contains the average statewide responses to the 2019 Virginia School Climate Survey administered in January-March 2019 by the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE), in partnership with the University of Virginia, as part of VDOE's work to support the efforts of schools and divisions to improve school climate.

62% of schools with grades 4 or 5 participated and 84% of their 4^{th} and 5^{th} graders completed a survey. This report summarizes the survey responses from 96,379 students.
