# 2019 Virginia School Climate Survey

Student Version - Grades 6 through 12

## Statewide

This report contains the average statewide responses to the 2019 Virginia School Climate Survey administered in January-March 2019 by the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE), in partnership with the University of Virginia, as part of VDOE's work to support the efforts of schools and divisions to improve school climate.

67% of schools with any grades 9 through 12 participated and 61% of their  $9^{th}$  through  $12^{th}$  graders completed a survey. This report summarizes the survey responses of 140,354 students.

Bullying makes the person being bullied feel intimidated or humiliated. Bullying happens more than once. The person being bullied has a hard time stopping it. Bullying includes cyber bullying. Bullying does not include teasing or horseplay. It is not bullying when two students who have the same power have a fight or an argument.
