Accent Modification services at the Sheila C. Johnson Center provide individualized services for students and adults for whom English is not their first language. Accent modification goals work to improve communicative effectiveness and confidence through instruction and practice.

The goal in accent modification training is to help the individual speak effectively so that speech is “listener friendly.”

After a careful analysis of the individual’s speech patterns, a customized training program is designed by a certified Speech-Language Pathologist and Associate Graduate Clinicians. We offer a limited number of 1:1 services each academic term. Services are provided on a first come, first serve basis.
