**Curry Faculty Scholarship**

Scholarship

*Established by the faculty of the Education School, this scholarship supports a Graduate student in any program. Recipients should demonstrate scholarship; co-curricular activities; community-professional activities; leadership; and service. Recipients must be recommended by School faculty.*

**Linda K. Bunker Scholarship**

Scholarship

*The Bunker Scholarship was established by former students, colleagues and friends of Dr. Bunker. This scholarship is open to students in Kinesiology, with preference to students studying motor learning, exercise and sport psychology, pedagogy, or adapted physical education.*

**Homer Humphreys Fellowship**

*The Humphreys Fellowship was established in honor of Homer Humphreys, a principal and teacher in Virginia and an adjunct faculty member at the School of Education and Human Development. The fellowship is given to a student in any graduate program with demonstrated financial need and academic merit.*
